

## **MINISTER OF RELIGION – SINDHI – HOLY MISSION OF GURU NANAK**

We are a Sindhi faith-based community and are a registered UK Charity with our common system of beliefs and spiritual goals, codes of behaviour and religious practice, which exists to support and/or propagate our faith and practices. We do not exclude membership from our community on the basis of gender, nationality or ethnicity. We seek to recruit a full-time Minister of Religion who will perform religious for our Mission's Centre (at 318 Cricklewood Broadway, London NW2 6QD) to lead regular worship and undertake pastoral duties for our expanding community.

### **Duties:**

1. To perform religious ceremonies and rites at family events such as births, deaths, engagements etc. which includes the use of Sindhi language.
2. The applicant will be responsible for liaison among members of the community and Management of the Board of the Charity, implement the decisions made, undertake associated administrative tasks, answer queries from public, supervise workings of some paid staff and carry out relevant religious and other management duties assigned to him from time to time by the Board maintaining overall day to day functioning of the Holy Mission.

### **Skills and Experience:**

3. The applicant will need to be or become very quickly familiar with the objectives and workings of our Charity and Sindhi faith community.
4. The applicant will have a knowledge of English to B1 level of the CEFL (Common European Framework for Language Learning) and fluency in Sindhi to communicate effectively with community and congregation, in particular the elderly, most of whom are unfamiliar with English language.
5. The applicant should be able to carry out the objectives of the Holy Mission effectively, i.e. religious and pastoral duties, welfare/humanitarian, cultural and related activities catering for the youth in the community as well as the elderly, organize regular programmes and activities with the help of volunteers.
6. Experience or ability in conducting large scale religious events and the ability to oversee the work of volunteers will be a definite advantage

**Remuneration package:** The stipend/customary offerings package include the following:

**£500pcm to cover stipend/customary offerings and out of pocket expenses plus rent free accommodation with meals** (NB. The position will be exempt from the NMW under Section 44A of National Minimum Wage Act 1998 - Weekly working hours are to be mutually agreed according to the needs of the community).
